

HELP! When I click on a name on this website to send an email, it doesn't work on my computer.

Throughout the Photography West web site we have provided email links for our various committee members and chair people. The web team has become aware that there are some members who are not able to click on a person's name and have that open a new email in their email program.

This is not a problem with the Photography West web site; it is just the way Microsoft Windows works. The problem is Windows, and what it does when you click on an email link on a web page.

Whenever you click on an email link on the Web, your computer may prompt you to set up email locally on your computer. If you prefer not to setup your email locally, the best way is to copy the email address, open your email program, click on compose, or new email, then paste the email address to the recipient area of the email composer.

To copy the email address, simply right-click on the email link and select "Copy Email Address" with a left mouse click. It would look similar to this:



Then simply go to your email program and paste that into the Send To or Recipient field.

If you are technically inclined, you might do a web search on "how to turn <Gmail/Yahoo/whatever email you use> into my windows default email client"
